

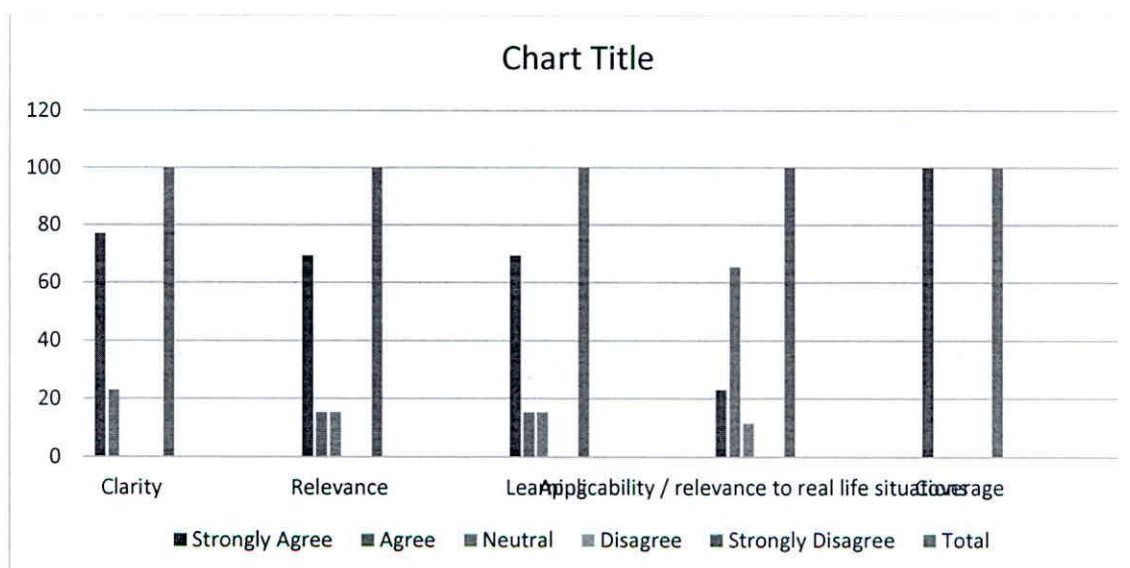

Programme Outcomes represent the knowledge, skills and attitudes a student should have at the end of a two/three/four/five year programme; for example : one of the programme outcomes of a programme in Physics could be - Solve complex and diverse problems by recognising universal physical laws relevant to the problem.

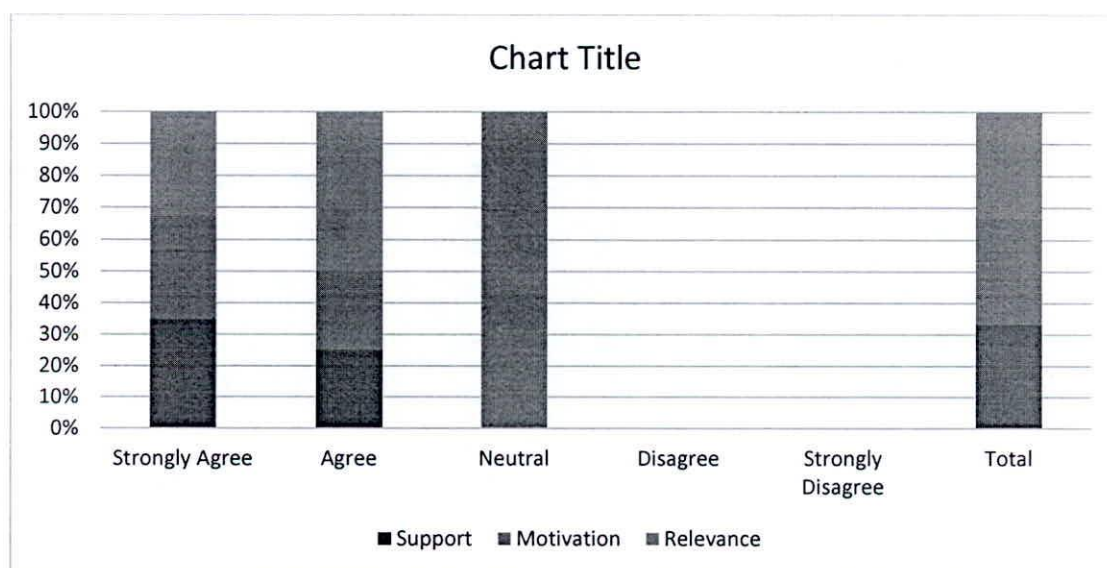
